Amgen (formerly Applied Molecular Genetics) is an American multinational biopharmaceutical company headquartered in Thousand Oaks, California. Amgen is the world’s largest independent biotechnology firm. Their commercial operation in the Republic of Ireland is based in Dublin. In Ireland they provide drug therapies for patients with cancer, renal and bone disease in hospital and in the community. Their medical team works with leading physicians throughout Ireland on numerous clinical research programmes.

Amgen bought the Pfizer site in 2011. Sirius had installed our BMS on the site when it was Pfizer. Earned Value Method was used for contract structure. Early contractor involvement (ECI) was used to engage Sirius and to allow Sirius to work with Jacobs engineering at the design stage of the project to mitigate risk and reduce the project execution timescale.
